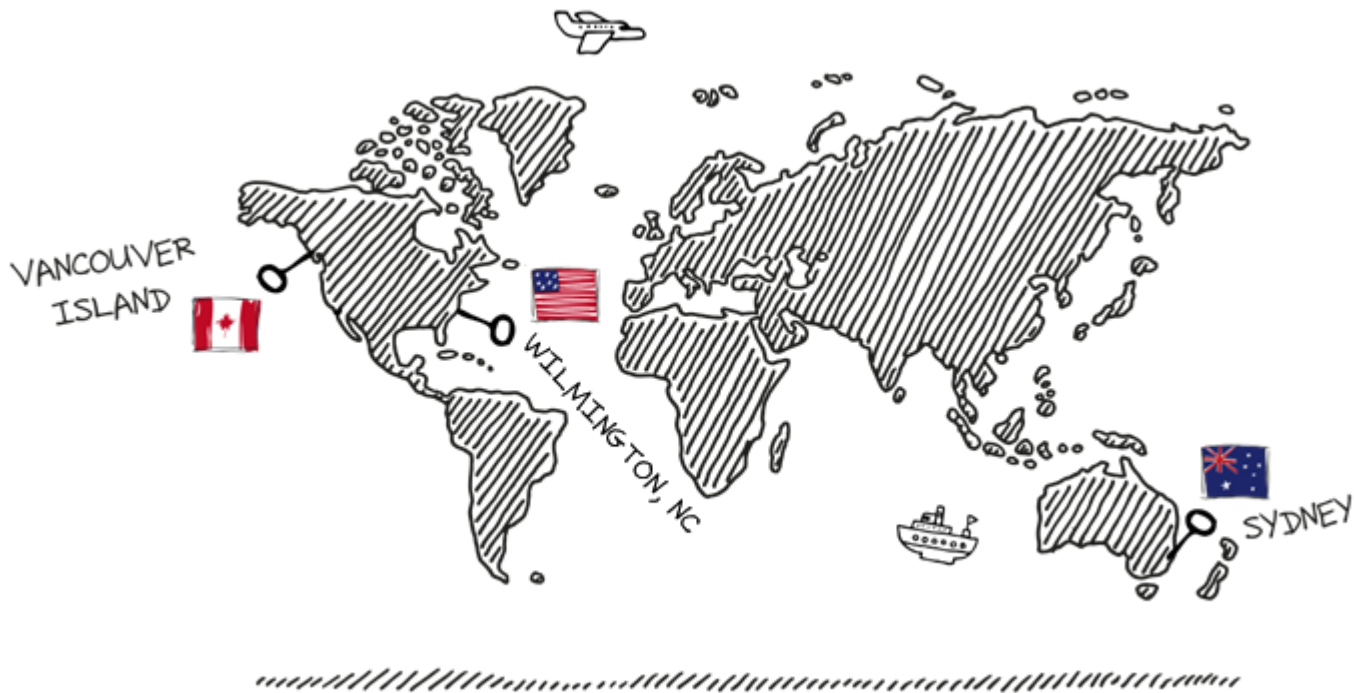

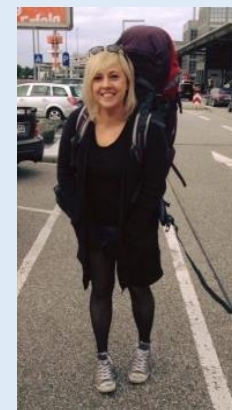

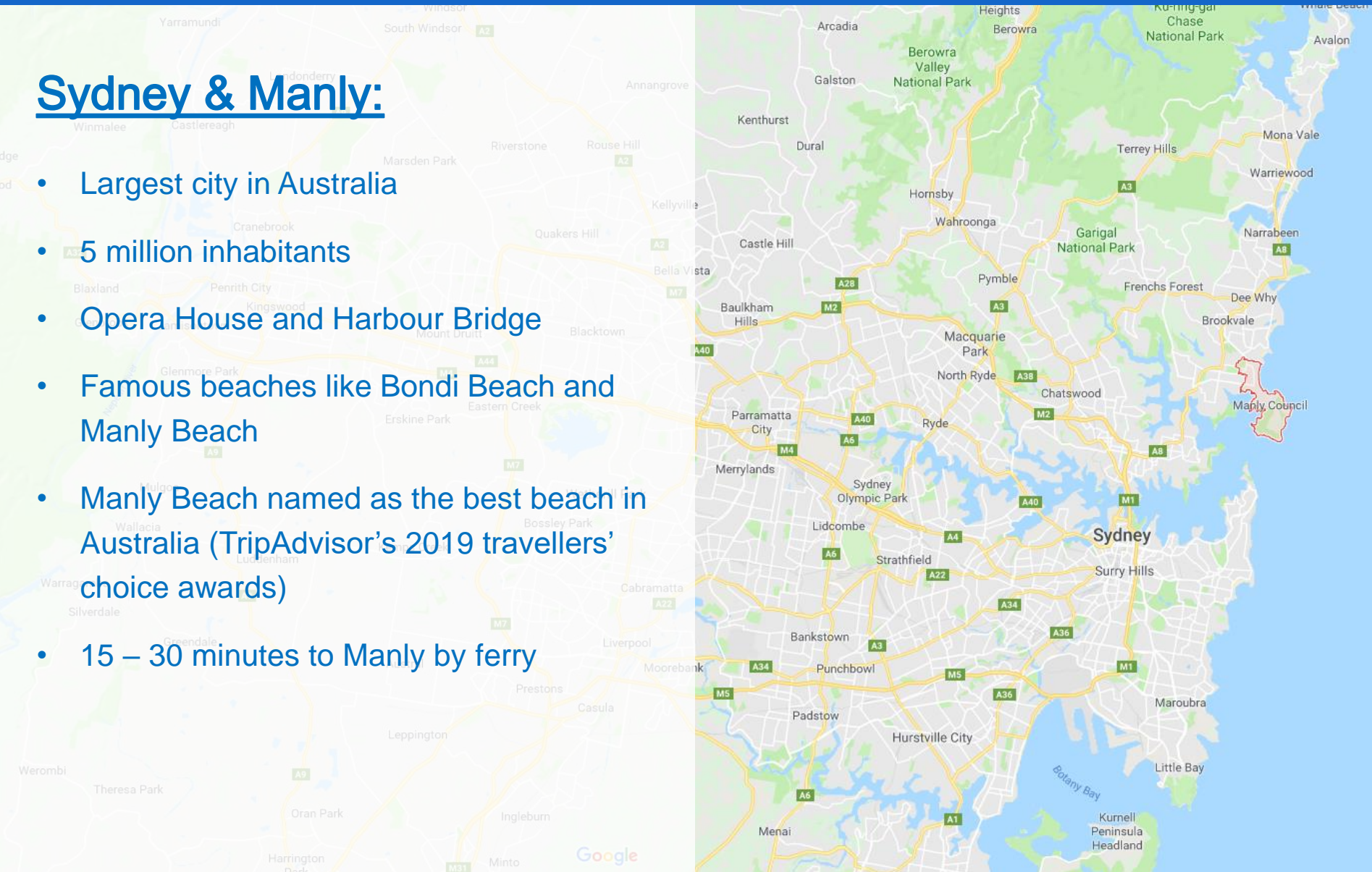






Sydney & Manly:

- Largest city in Australia

Double Degree:

- Receive an ICMS degree in addition to the degree of your home institution
- Gain work experience in Australia
- Master Double Degree:
2 trimester + work integrated industry research project (600 hours) at ICMS
- Bachelor Double Degree:
2 trimester + Industry training (600 - 1200 hours) at ICMS



Studying at ICMS:

- Bachelor students pick min. 3 courses (22.5 ECTS) per trimester (13 weeks)
- Master students pick 3 courses (30 ECTS) per trimester (13 weeks)
- 1,5 hrs lecture and 1,5 hrs tutorial
- Grading: midterm, finals, quizzes, presentations, homework, group work
- Receive practical training thanks to professional instructors



Intakes 2022:

Bachelor & Master (Trimester)

- February Term (Beginning of February – Beginning of May)
- May Term (Mid- May – Mid of August)
- August Term (End of August – End of November)

→ *Apply 3-6 months prior course start*

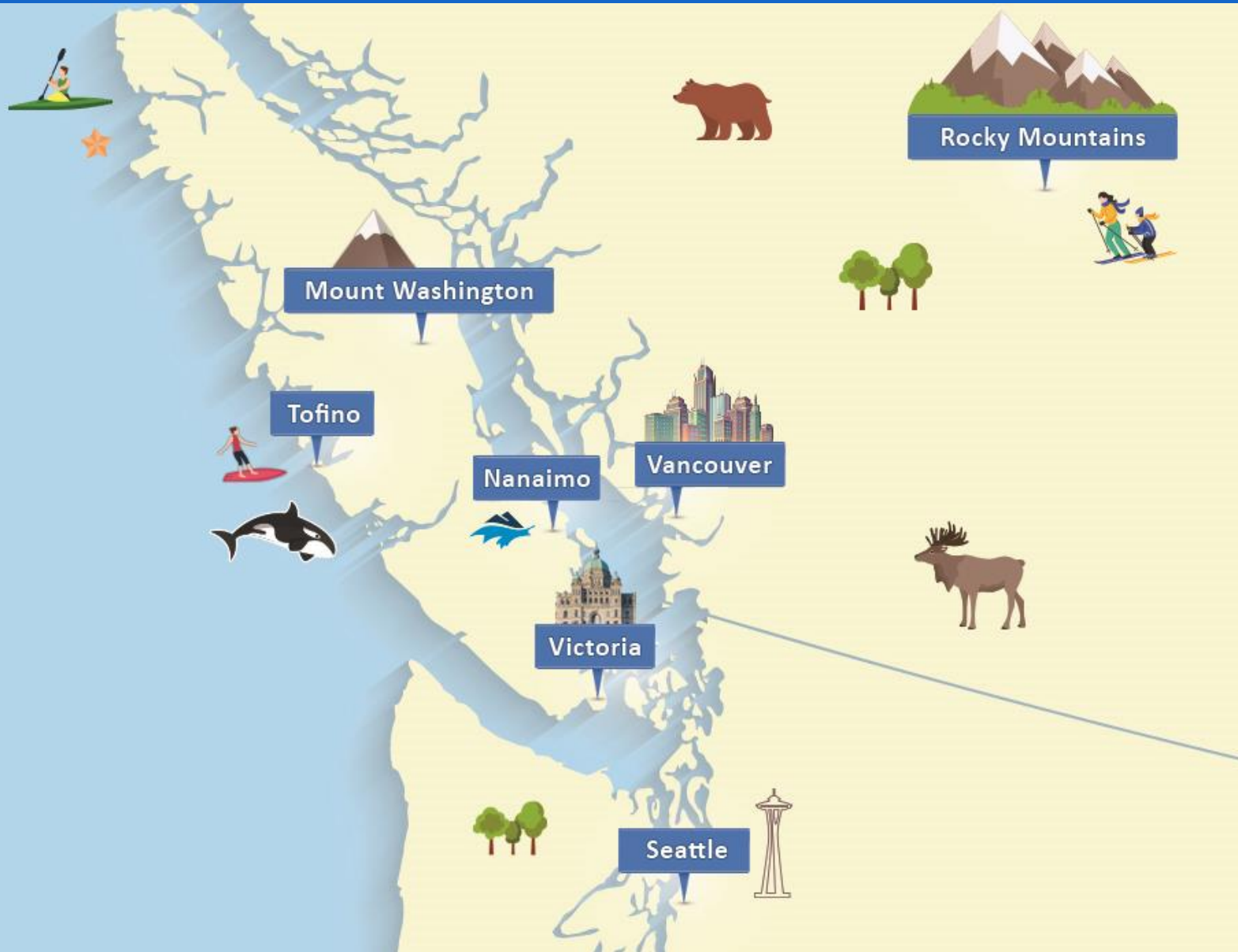

→ Apply by March 31, 2022 for September 2022 and January 2023 (late applications can often be accepted)

- Southern Cuisine (seafood, Cajun etc.)

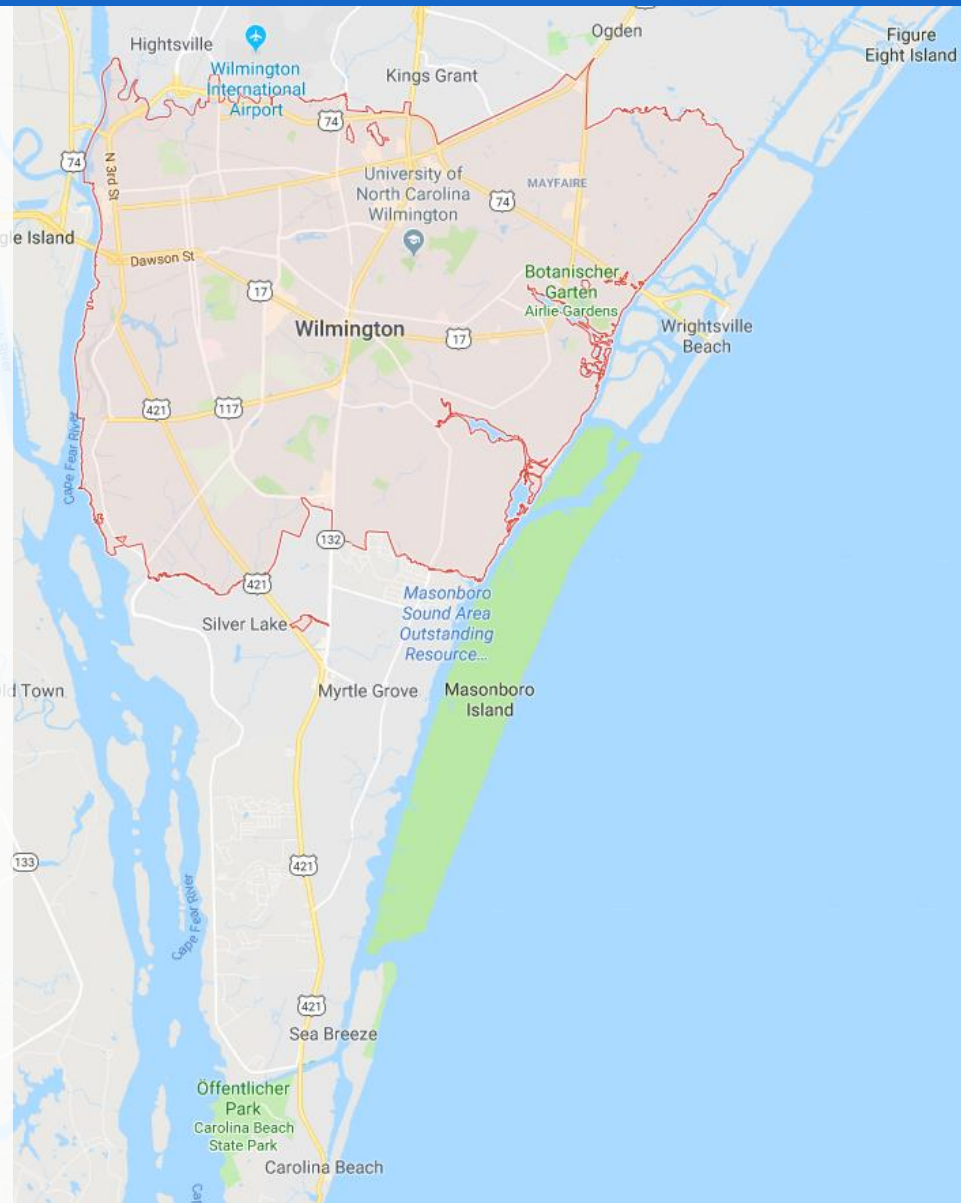


Figure Eight Island



UNCW:

- UNCW is a NC state university (in total 16 state universities in the NC system)
- One of the 50 best public universities in the US - Cameron School of Business (AACSB accredited)
- Campus size - 661 acres with 161 buildings (= 500 football fields)
- 18,000 students
- Average class size: 22
- 15 min to the beach (bike)
- Mascot: “Sammy C. Hawk“





Study Areas:

- **Arts & Sciences** (Chemistry, Physics, Psychology, Computer Sciences)
 - **Business Studies** (Finance, Marketing, Accounting, Management, Economics)
 - **Health & Human Services** (Social Sciences, Politics, Social Work)
 - **Education & Languages**
 - **Art & Design & Performing Arts** (Theater, Film Studies, Music)
- International study abroad students are allowed to mix and match from all areas of study



Study Abroad Term:

- Start in January or August
- 4 courses (= ca. 24 ECTS) is the minimum work load as a full-time Bachelor student (max. 6 courses per semester)
- Master students must pick between 3 and 5 courses
- Mix & match courses from all schools & colleges (Bachelor-level)
- Grading: essays, tutorials, presentations, group work, midterm exams, final exams etc. as well as attendance and participation





Campus Life:

- 60 sports clubs (e.g. Archery Club, Quidditch, Sailing, Surfing etc.)

Tuition Fees*:

Bachelor students:

- 7,662 USD / semester (~ 6,606€)

Master students:

- 7,672 – 10,058 USD / semester
(~ 6,600€ - 8,700€)
- IMBA (24 ECTS): 8,483 USD / semester
(~ 7,300€)

Reduction: 3,000 USD (already included for Bachelor and Master, not applicable to IMBA)

On-Campus Housing:

- Safe, affordable and well-maintained residential facilities

- Starting at 3,341 USD / semester (~ 2,880 €)

Next Steps





Admission Requirements:

- Application Form / Online Application
- Official Transcripts in English
- Proof of English Proficiency: TOEFL, IELTS, or DAAD
- Passport Copy
- Choice of Courses (not VIU)

For the US: Bank Statement showing sufficient funds to cover your study abroad term





Application Process:

- Check deadlines with your home university
- Contact our ISO office → we help you with the application and send you all the information and forms you need
- Send application to our office / apply online
- Receive enrollment documents
- Apply for visa / study permit / eTA



Student Visa:

- Australia: apply online (biometrics might be needed)
- Canada: apply online for eTA or study permit (biometrics needed)
- United States:
 - apply online for J-1 interview at US embassy
 - Visa application process may take up to 1-2 months
 - Travel grace period (US) 60 days
 - Internship opportunity with J-1 visa



Working:

- **Australia:** You are allowed to work on and off campus - minimum wage AUD 19.50 per hour
- **Canada:** Working on campus up to 20 hours with **study permit** - working off campus only for full degree students
- **United States:** Non-Degree Students are NOT allowed to work off-campus - on-campus jobs are available at UNCW





Health insurance:

- You need to have health insurance during your study abroad semester
 - Australia OSHC / Canada VIU insurance
 - For the US these 2 requirements must be fulfilled by your provider:
 - Max. 50.00 USD deductible
 - Min. 250,000 USD coverage per illness/injury
- Take proof of health insurance coverage with you to the orientation day!
- E.g. Hanse-Merkur via our website



Scholarships:

- 3 - 4 x scholarships per year for international students at ISO universities
 - Reduction of tuition fees or housing stipends
 - Apply before December 15 / June 15
- Photo & Video Contest by ISO
- DAAD scholarships & DAAD database
- HAW scholarship
- Fulbright Commission (US only)





Financial Aid:

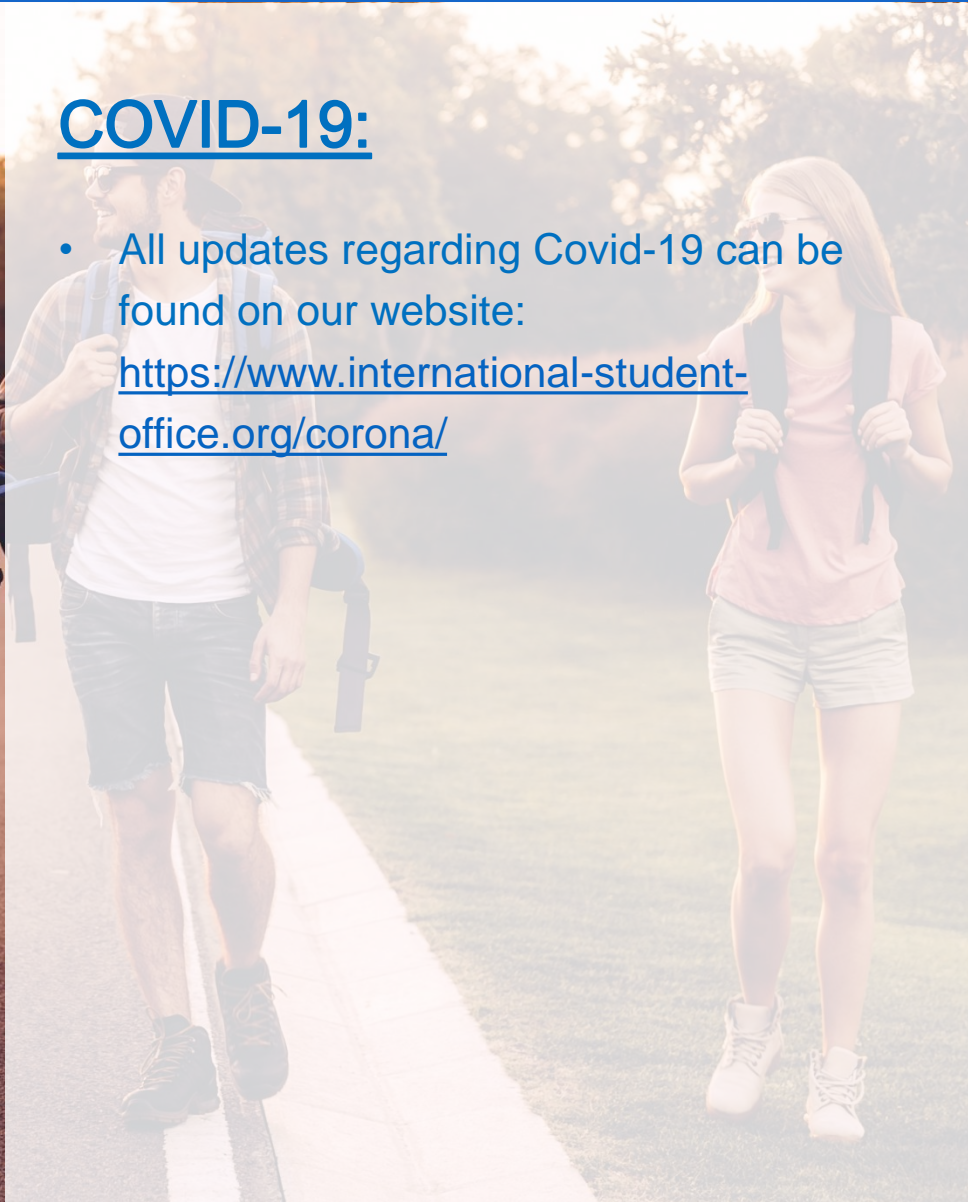
- Auslands-BAföG
 - up to 4.600 EUR for tuition fees
 - 1.000 EUR travel expenses
 - Monthly allowance
