Housing Information		
Application procedures for housing	The university has its own dormitories and hotels. Accommodation for students costs 500 PLN/per month/ per person in a double room. We do not guarantee accommodation for all students.  The cost of living in Poland can vary and depends on personal demands and life style. In general, to cover basic monthly expenses while living in Warsaw foreign students would need about 380-600 EUR.	
	Erasmus+ students are accommodated in double rooms with common bathrooms and kitchens. The WSU dormitory does not offer single rooms. The rooms are fully furnished (carpet, beds, bed sheets, tables, chairs, lamp,refrigerator). We suggest to take with you, or be ready to buy here in Warsaw your own cutlery and dishes. All rooms have Internet access (without additional fees). Due to high number of the Internet users we do not guarantee good quality of wi-fi all the time.	
	Students are kindly asked to pay via bank transfer in PLN until 25th of each month. An internal parking place needs to be reserved in advance. It is forbidden to smoke or drink alcohol at the dormitory.

Additional Useful Information	
Meals	The university provides the opportunity to use the services of the canteen which offers tasty home-like cuisine. The canteen has 280 places for guests who can be served at the same time. The cost of full board in the canteen is about 40 PLN a day. In the surroundings of WSU there are also bakeries, grocery stores, bistro and restaurants.
Language Courses	Students have the opportunity to study Polish Language during their study period.
Medical facilities	Foreign students can benefit from medical services generally available after getting the insurance in their own country. The European Health Insurance Card facilitates the use of the Polish medical system. We recommend arranging the card. Private services can be used in clinics or private clinics (the average price of the visit is approx. 100-150 PLN).
