### I Motivation

The survey has been realized as part of the project GeNECA, funded by the German ministry of Science.

The GeNECA-Project aims to link the concepts of Sustainable Human Development (SHD) with the ideas of the Capability Approach (CA)



## I Empirical Application – SOEP(-IS)

# <u>Database Infrastructure for the German Socio-Economic Panel</u> SOEP(core)

- Representative annual longitudinal household survey since 1984
- Regular Inclusion of new subsamples
- in 2010: 10.840 households, with 28.436 persons

### **SOEP-IS (SOEP Innovation Sample)**

- Established in 2011 (based on subsamples of SOEPcore)
- Realized for the period from 2012 to 2017, (target size 5.000 households)
- Goal: Increase of SOEP core and ...
- Inclusion of innovative survey modules, experiments and tests

• The Subsample of the German Innovation Sample (SOEP-IS) —as part of the longitudinal data infrastructure of the German Socio-economic Panel study (SOEP) provides in 2012 a new module on direct CA-measures and related concepts based on high level representative data.

### **General information**

• From 2013 on, SOEP will determine the contents of SOEP-IS through a competitive refereed application process for the "best" research questions and their operationalizations, and will distribute the SOEP-IS data as part of its regular data releases. (Richter/Schupp SOEPpapers 463, 2012)



### I Fieldwork

 Empirical Application are realized as part of SOEP-IS (Fieldwork June/July – Oct/Nov 2012);
 Very first results are based on preliminary data (N=595)

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    Respondents (N=~1100)
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- Individuals (N=~1500)
- Households (N=~550)



## II Empirical Application – SOEP-IS

### **SOEP Innovation Sample (SOEP-IS), Modules and Splits**

### **Basic Instruments**

- Household Survey (housing, income, socio-demographics)
- Personal Survey (employment, health, satisfaction)
- Mother/Parents-Child-Surveys (Modules related to own children in household: (1)
   0-23 months; (2) 24-47 months (3) >= 48 months;
- Biographical Survey (education, employment, migration, parents, siblings)

### Innovation Modules in 2012 (Personal Survey, Splits)

- I [Life: Education, unemployment]
- II [Daily Reconstruction Method (DRM);
- III [GEB /Environmental Behavior]
- IV [Investment decisions; Control striving]
- V GeNECA (Split 1+2): Measures on QoL, CA, SD, SC



## I Conceptional Framework –CA-SD & QoL-

Three related theoretical frameworks – QoL, CA, and SD

- interdisciplinary
- multidimensional
- policy driven (social indicators)
- global perspective

The concepts for the CA and SD are both explicitly related to multidimensional quality of life (QoL) (Maggino, 2009).



### I Conceptional Framework – CA

The CA framework highlights aspects of having the abilities to live in valued ways.

- Despite the growing awareness for the capability approach (CA) in quantitative research, the operationalization of the CA based on direct questions is not yet established in representative surveys.
- We included therefore direct indicators on capability dimensions like freedom, autonomy, opportunities, constraints.
- The dimension of autonomy is further included as part of the psychological scale on basic needs according to self determination theory (SDT-Scale).



### I Conceptional Framework – SD

The underlying CA dimensions on opportunities and constraints are also of particular importance for the preservation of living conditions within the SHD context.

### The SHD framework ...

- ecological (regional and global) perspectives
- and with intergenerational perspectives with regards to the preservation of living conditions to further generations.





## I Self Determination Theory (SDT-Scale)

### <u>SDT – Self Determination Theory</u>

- Self Determination Theory (SDT) claims that an understanding of human motivation requires a consideration of innate psychological needs for competence, autonomy, and relatedness.
- Self Determination Theory is concerned primarily with explaining the psychological processes that promote optimal functioning and health.
- The Basic Psychological Needs Scale from Deci/Ryan (2000) is one of the main concepts to measure SDT issues.
- We use the general form of the scale in a reduced set of items (9 items in total, 3 item for each dimension)
- (Further sdt-scales refer to work and relationships)




#### **Overall Satisfaction with life**


### **Opportunities in general**


### **Justice - living conditions (in Germany)**







## Fair living conditions in Germany and worldwide








### Importance (0: totally unimportant, 10: totally important)

#### Satisfaction (0=totally unsatisfied, 10=totally satisfied)






#### Opportunities (1: very bad 7: very good)






## QoL-SD (Improvement / Decline)

#### Expected Improvement/Decline, sum 3 areas, absolute




## Qol-SD Concerns (Millenium Goals)

### Concerns (3=big, 2=some, 1=no)

#### The 8 Millennium Goals:

- 1. eradicating extreme poverty and hunger,
- 2. achieving universal primary education,
- promoting <u>gender equality</u> and empowering women
- 4. reducing child mortality rates,
- 5. improving maternal health,
- 6. combating <u>HIV/AIDS</u>, <u>malaria</u>, and other diseases,
- 7. ensuring environmental sustainability, and
  - a. Integrate the principles of sustainable development into country policies and programs; reverse loss of environmental resources
  - b. Reduce <u>biodiversity</u> loss, achieving, by 2010, a significant reduction in the rate of loss
  - Halve, by 2015, the proportion of the population without sustainable access to safe drinking water and basic <u>sanitation</u> (for more information see the entry on <u>water supply</u>)
  - d. By 2020, to have achieved a significant improvement in the lives of at least 100 million slumdwellers
- 8. developing a global partnership for development.






### Contribution of actors to sustainable development
