Profile: M-CMI prepares leaders of the armed forces and IO/NGO executives for careers across the spectrum of Civil-Military Interation. The inter-organizational study program is offered by the Helmut Schmidt University/University of the German Armed Forces Hamburg (HSU/UniBw H) and supported by Civil-Military Cooperation Centre of Excellence (CCOE) in The Hague, The Netherlands. The curriculum consists of didactic and practical components in German and/or English.

The M-CMI is ideal for expanding networks and developing expertise while pursuing a professional career.

Content & Structure:

- **Compulsory Modules:** leadership & management, empirical social research, NATO CIMIC Higher Command Course and Field & Staff Worker Course.
- **Elective Modules:** strategic concepts, human rights, international policy analysis, cross-cultural studies, and conflict management.
- Preparatory academic writing seminar and master thesis.

Degree: Master of Arts in CMI (M.A.).

Duration: 2 years (60 ECTS).

Mode of Study: The online format with short resident block seminars is ideal for the working professional.

Admission requirements:

- Bachelor and/or Master degree with a minimum of 240 ECTS.
- Minimum 2 years working experience with at least one year of management responsibilities.
- English language skills (minimum B2).
