

## Call for Papers – Formats

# "Commitment to Society – Education and Training for Operational and Emergency Forces of the Future"

Dear authors,

We are delighted that you are interested in submitting an abstract for the Bundeswehr Education and Training Convention 2019.

Please note that submissions will be evaluated by means of a review process. This will involve rendering the abstracts anonymous and forwarding them to members of the programme committee, who will then select the contributions for the panels. The programme committee consists of education experts from the scientific community, the public sector, associations and the Bundeswehr.

There are three possible formats for contributions:

- **Presentation** (45 minutes) or
- **Forum** (90 minutes) or
- **Workshop** (90 minutes)

A **presentation** allows you to present certain aspects, problems and questions regarding the main topic in more depth. The presentation should be structured to allow sufficient time at the end for you and the participants to discuss questions and results.

In the **forum**, which you will be moderating, you will have the opportunity, together with several speakers, to give keynote speeches on the main topic and to discuss them with the participants. If possible, each keynote speech should contain one or two lines of argument, which will be discussed in greater depth with the participants.

The **workshop** should be planned as a working group. The aim is for you to work together with the participants to produce a common result or product relating to the main topic. These may be, for example, common positions, recommendations, guidelines or solution approaches to the

problems presented. It must be possible to document the result so that it may subsequently be made available to interested experts, for example.

If possible, the forum as well as the workshop should have several speakers. You are responsible for organising these formats and coordinating their content. Furthermore, when submitting the abstract, a lead speaker should be named who will be the point of contact for the convention's organisational team. The use of different media is recommended when creating the contributions.

### **Your contribution on the SCIENCE panel**

On the SCIENCE panel, representatives from the scientific and research community will throw light on various perspectives pertaining to the main topic. Challenges and areas for action will be identified in order to intensify discussion between experts and actors from the education sector.

The aim of the SCIENCE panel is to present the current state of research on the topic of the convention by means of a scientifically founded, lively and open discussion. This will essentially involve examining theoretical and empirical principles, as well as models illustrating current research approaches and their relevance to science and society. Concepts and practical research activities relating to the main topic of the convention may also be presented and analysed. The focus will be on contributions identifying future challenges for society and highlighting suitable areas for action in which concepts can be implemented.

The following criteria will apply when selecting contributions for the SCIENCE panel:

- Scientific relevance to the main topic of the convention
- General relevance of the topic
- Research interest generated by the contribution
- Transparent presentation of issues and methods
- Quality of the methodological approach
- Quality of obtained data and analysis
- Comprehensibility of the scientific debate
- An international and interdisciplinary approach is desirable

### **Your contribution on the PRACTICE panel**

The PRACTICE panel offers a platform for presenting and discussing examples from practice for practice and for stimulating ideas. The primary aim is to enable the transfer of knowledge for use

in the participants' own work in education and training. This will involve presenting current developments, trends, challenges, solution approaches and success stories.

The aim of the PRACTICE panel is to highlight strategies and fundamental conceptual developments, the didactic-methodological utilisation of new technologies, trends and new fields of knowledge and their importance for education and training. Projects, best-practice examples and evaluations may also be presented and discussed. The focus will be on the exchange of experience and the presentation of sustainable and customer-oriented solutions for education and training.

The following criteria will apply when selecting contributions for the PRACTICE panel:

- Relevance to the main topic of the convention
- General relevance of the topic for education and training
- Research interest generated by the contribution / possibility of directly implementing the new idea
- Practical relevance / best practice in the context of the respective institution
- If possible, relevance to pilot concepts / projects of these institutions
- Existing results, information on implementation and on subsequent activities
- An international and interdisciplinary approach is desirable

### **Submission of abstracts**

Young professionals as well as trainees, together with their instructors, are urged to submit contributions reflecting their experiences and perspectives.

Please send us your abstract by 15 March 2019. Following deliberation by the programme committee we will let you know by 17 May 2019 whether your contribution has been accepted. Please use the form provided when submitting your abstract and please also note that, if your contribution is accepted, your abstract will be printed in the convention catalogue in the version submitted. Your abstract should contain a **maximum** of 2,300 characters (including blank spaces).

Please do not submit promotional contributions as we are unable to consider them when planning the programme for the SCIENCE and PRACTICE panels.
