

Formalities and Criteria

„A watershed era“ – How to overcome the challenges?

We are inviting experts and professionals from the fields of education and training and the sciences (education, social, humanities and liberal arts, engineering and technology as well as economics) and business experts and teaching staff, members of the armed forces for the Bundeswehr Education and Training Convention 2023 to hand in their contributions. You have the chance to contribute via the panel **SCIENCE** and **PRAXIS**. Additionally, after the convention you have the opportunity to publish your contribution via a book of conference proceedings¹.

In the following part you can retrieve the information for the **possible formats** of your contributions and the **formal criteria**.

1. Possible Formats

- **Workshop**

This format is designed to be interactive. The goal is, for the participating audience to work along in the framework of a 90-minute discussion in order to create a common product. This could include common positions, recommendations, guidelines or solutions and measures to the problem at hand. The result should be in a format to be taken in written form, so it can be presented in a plenary address.

- **Forum**

You have the opportunity to discuss the issue at hand with other consultants and experts and present it in a plenary address. If possible there will be short presentations of one to two issues, including statements or possible propositions, that are to be critically discussed and addressed in the framework of 90 minutes.

- **Vortrag**

This format offers the possibility to present specific issues, questions and propositions. The lecture should be no longer than 45 minutes to enable a round of discussion for another 45 minutes.

- **Poster**

The presentation has a framework of 10 minutes (pitch). The goal is to present the audience with the core content of the issue at hand regarding the convention. The poster should be visually pleasing and comprehensible for the audience to follow and offer room for discussion.

2. Formal Criteria

The following criteria will be used to assess your submission for the panels science and praxis:

Panel Science

- Scientific connection to the guideline of the convention
- Visible relevance of the contribution
- Clear depiction of the intent for insights of the contribution
- Visible depiction of the question and methods used
- Quality of the applied methods and obtained data and analysis
- Replicability of the scientific arguments and conclusiveness
- Internationality and transdisciplinary is welcomed

Panel Practice

- Clear and distinct reference to the themes of the convention
- Apparent relevance for the subject of education and training
- Visible possibility for the transition of the provided impulse
- Clear reference to praxis of the field (best practice) of the respective context of the institution
- If possible, reference to models or pilot projects of the respective institution
- Indication for implementation and further proceedings
- Internationality and transdisciplinary is welcome
